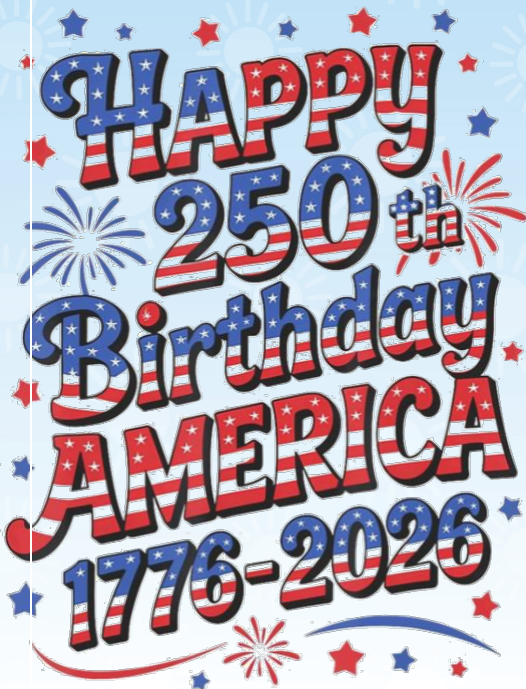

Summer Fun in Assisted Living

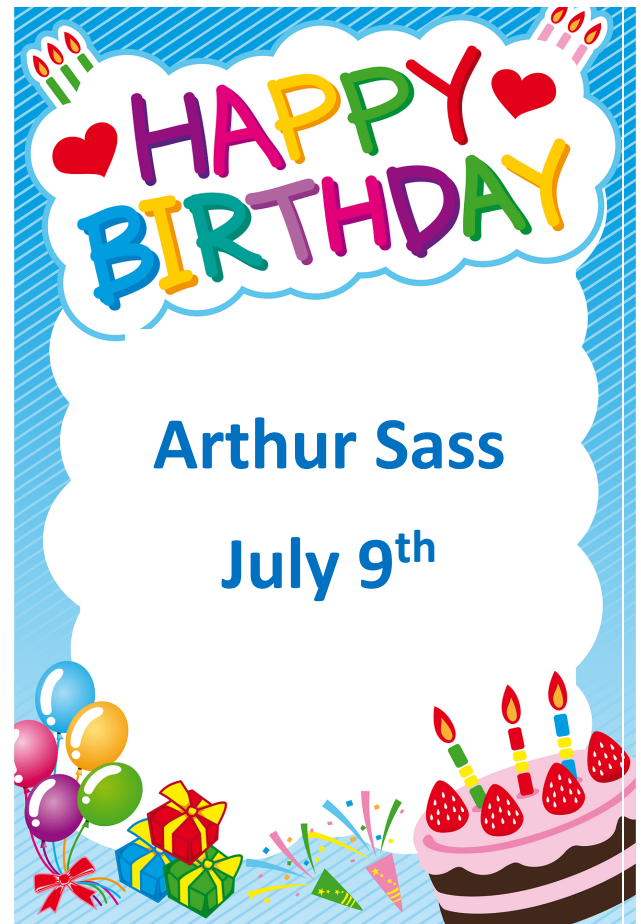
As we reflect on the month of June, we're filled with gratitude for the wonderful memories we created together with our residents, families, and staff.
